A RESOLUTION ADVOCATING VOTER OPPOSITION TO PROPOSITION HH

WHEREAS, the La Plata Archuleta Water District (the “**District**”) is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado and a duly organized and existing special district pursuant to Title 32, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, Proposition HH will appear on the statewide ballot in the November 7, 2023 Election; and

WHEREAS, if Proposition HH passes, the District will suffer substantial revenue reductions, and the District’s ability to function effectively and provide the most basic level of service will be impaired; and

WHEREAS, if Proposition HH passes, the District’s property tax revenues will be cut substantially and, as a result, the District will be forced to delay projects and reduce services in the future; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Fair Campaign Practices Act authorizes special districts to adopt resolutions of support or opposition to ballot issues, and it is the desire of the Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of the District to express its unanimous opposition to Proposition HH; and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds and determines that it is appropriate and necessary to the function and operation of the District to adopt this Resolution urging voters to oppose Proposition HH.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the La Plata Archuleta Water District that the Board hereby expresses its strongest possible opposition to Proposition HH; and further the voters of the District are encouraged to **vote “NO”** on Proposition HH at the November 7, 2023 Election; and further confirms that, if passed, Proposition HH threatens to impair the District’s ability to construct, maintain and provide the services and public infrastructure improvements now being provided for the health, safety and welfare of current and future District residents.
